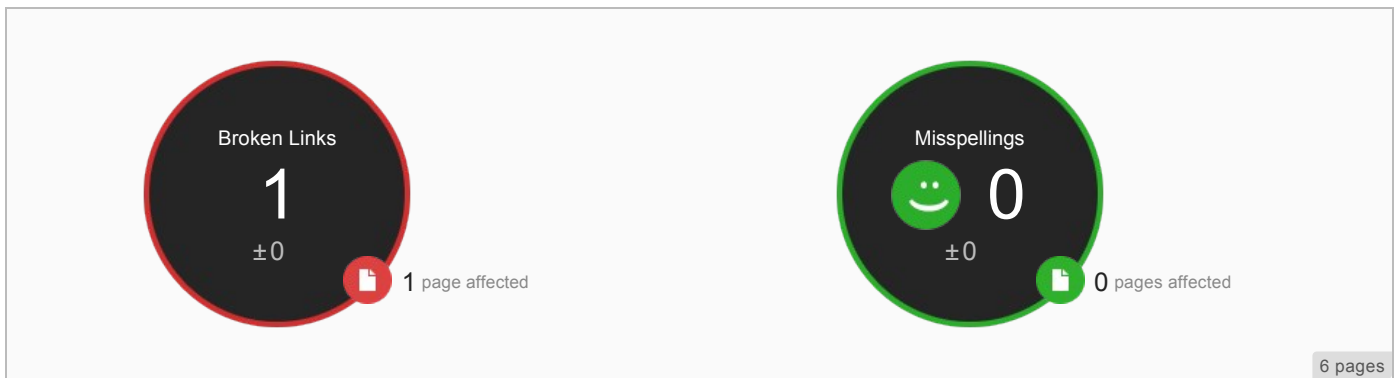

Priority pages

Pages with errors have a page score to enable you to target those pages where corrections will have the most positive effect for your users. The table displays all pages on the site with a page score less than 10, and pages are by default ordered in regards to page score, with the lowest score first.

Glossary

- **Page score:**

Every page on the site is given a page score calculated not only in regards to the number of broken links and misspellings, but also page level.

In this way a page with a broken link that is located closer to the home page, and therefore more likely to be seen by visitors to the site, is given more priority than a page located on a lower level also with 1 broken link.

The page score ranges from 0-10. A score of 10 indicates that the page has no link or spelling errors, so any page with a score of less than 10 appears on the priority pages list.

- **Priority pages:**

With the page score in focus, Priority Pages enables you to target the pages where corrections will have the most positive effect for your users.

We know from experience that our customers do not have the luxury of time to set aside in order to correct errors on the website. So when they get an opportunity to target errors on the site, the data needs to be at hand immediately within Quality Assurance.
