**Bhut Jolokia, a.k.a. Ghost
Pepper – Limited Quantity**



We have just obtained a small quantity of fresh Bhut Jolokia chile seeds (*C. chinense* x *C. frutescens*) by special arrangement with New Mexico's Chile Pepper Institute. Also known as the "Ghost Pepper" and now listed in the Guinness Book of World Records, the super incendiary Bhut Jolokia has tested at an unbelievable 1 million Scoville heat units, over twice as hot as our ultra fiery Red Savina habaneros, 200 times hotter than Jalapenos and 400 times as hot as Tabasco sauce!

Bhut Jolokia's tapered, somewhat wrinkled fruits are about 2 1/2 to 3 inches in length and 1 1/4 inches wide, and mature from green to orange red to red in color. The branching plants grow about 3 to 3 1/2 feet tall.
