Jan. 1	Panelist application opens (faculty nomination and student letter of interest can be submitted)
Jan. 1 - Feb. 28	Reach out to other higher education institutes
Feb. 7	Domenici Panelists and Scholars Program information session at 9:00 a.m. in Domenici Hall, room 252 (see main page for online support)
Feb. 14	Domenici Panelists and Scholars Program information session at 3:00 p.m. in Domenici Hall, room 252 (see main page for online support)
March 30	Panelist application closes (faculty nomination and student letter of interest must both be received by this date)
April 11	Applicants are notified of their acceptance and eligibility to participate in the Domenici Student Scholars Program
April 20	Deadline for selected panelists to confirm participation and submit speaker/topic preferences
April 27	Panelists receive team assignments and team leaders are announced as selected by the advisory committee
May 16	Advisory committee briefs team leaders (i.e., leader roles, expectations for panelists, general info) via conference call
May 17 - July 10	Orientation and Q&A sessions
July 11	Panelists complete 1st assignment (speaker report) and post to shared web platform for feedback
July 18	Panelists complete 2nd assignment (theme report) and post to shared web platform for feedback
July 25	Panelists complete 3rd assignment (draft questions): post initial draft questions to shared web platform for feedback
July 25	Mandatory Introduction for those considering PVDI Scholar Program
July 30	Deadline for panelists and committee members to provide written feedback on draft questions
Aug. 1-31	Panelists conduct additional research, as directed, and post revised questions to shared web platform for ongoing feedback
Aug. 17	Scholar candidates participate in a workshop; students must have 3-credit class with faculty mentor: **Domenici Hall, room 252 from 4 - 6 pm
Sept. 6	Panelists post final questions to shared web platform
Sept. 11	Domenici Student Panelists participate in dinner and work session
Sept. 12-13	<b>Domenici Public Policy Conference</b>
Oct. 3	**Scholar candidates participate in cohort meeting (faculty mentors invited) to discuss proposal process and exchange ideas among group

Dec. 7	Regents recognition of students and mentors: recognized as <b>Domenici Student Scholars</b>

Jan. 11	For Domenici Student Scholars opting to be considered for accession into the Domenici Student Scholar Research Papers (DSSRP) housed in the NMSU Library's Archives and Special Collection, PVDI compiles work to Editorial Review Board (ERB)
Jan. 12 - Feb. 7	Scholars will be advised of ERB final outcome by PVDI, at which point a Deed of Gift signed by scholar may be required
